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## Chip Cards Are Coming To The USA: Here's What You Need To Know

EMV – short for Europay, MasterCard, and Visa is a new standard for secure credit and debit card payment transactions and is already used around the world and is being deployed in the U.S. The EMV “chip” is a secure microprocessor built into a card or other payment device that generates a unique number for each transaction. Starting October 2015, card networks agree to shift financial responsibility for losses due to counterfeit card-present card fraud to the party using the least secure technology. Merchants who wish to avoid this should implement EMV chip technology in their point-of-sale (POS) devices. PCI DSS compliance will still be necessary after EMV POS devices are implemented.

### Why should my business move to the EMV Standard?

- ✓ Improves transaction security for credit and debit card-present environments
- ✓ Creates a global cardholder experience
- ✓ Bundles emerging technologies and provides merchants capabilities to accept payments in new ways
- ✓ If you choose not to switch to an EMV card process, your company will be held responsible for the costs associated with counterfeit.

### Should my company update POS hardware and PIN pad devices?

- ✓ Review with your provider about existing POS equipment to learn if upgrades are possible or if new EMV-compatible hardware must be purchased
- ✓ Check to determine whether or not your standalone POS has a slot for EMV cards. These are typically located at the bottom of the terminal. It is different from the magnetic side swipe.
- ✓ If your company owns an integrated POS system, contact the software provider to inquire if an upgrade or new POS hardware is needed.
- ✓ If your utilizing a payment gateway for processing payments, check to be sure that they have gone thru EMV testing and certification. Any e-commerce payment gateways operating in a card not present environment will not need changes.

## ALERE Tips & Tricks Corner

How to Invoice and Ship an Accepted Single Sales Order

1. In the **Sales Module**, select **Orders**
2. Go to the **Status** tab
3. Select **Function** to perform: *Ship Only, Invoice Only, Ship and Invoice, Invoice Shipped Items*
4. Select lines and quantities to release. To specify shipping location check **Ask** column
5. Click the **Release** button
6. Apply shipping charges as appropriate
7. If the **Assign Location** screen pops up, select locations and quantities
8. If all processing is complete, click the **Done** button

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### **A Must Read If You Utilize the Sage 300 Payroll Module**

With the forthcoming release of Sage 300 2016, Sage will release version 7.2 of the Payroll Module in Sage 300. Starting January 2016, support for previous Sage 300 Payroll versions (6.0, 7.0 and 7.1) will be discontinued along with the tax updates for these versions. The last tax update for Sage Payroll 6.0 was released in July 2015 for Canadian Payroll and will be in September 2015 for US Payroll.

Any Sage 300 customers using Payroll versions other than 7.2A will need to upgrade by December 31, 2015 in order to stay in compliance with payroll tax updates and reporting requirements. The latest version of Sage 300 Payroll will also allow your company to file the required ACA 1094 and 1095 forms. These are new reporting requirements imposed by the IRS. The first mandatory submission is February 29, 2016 for the 2015 year.
